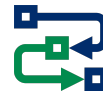




Indiana Level of Care Assessment Representative (LCAR)

Attention MCE and Nursing Facility Staff: New Submission Option for NF Residents Due for Three-Year Level of Care (LOC) Reassessment

Process Update:



Currently, nursing facility residents receiving long term care and enrolled with a PathWays Managed Care Entity (MCE) have a Level of Care (LOC) reassessment completed by an MCE Service Coordinator every three (3) years. **Effective immediately** nursing facility residents receiving long term care and enrolled with a PathWays MCE, will have their LOC reassessment every three (3) years, completed by the nursing facility staff.

The MCE is no longer required to submit LOC reassessments for nursing facility residents receiving long term care. Nursing facility staff are responsible for submitting the LOC assessment on the individual's behalf. This process change removes the MCE from performing this process and is intended to streamline and reduce unnecessary administration to the provider and individual.

Please ensure your teams are aware of this change and implement this into your workflow for upcoming 3-year assessments.
